Dear Parents, Carers and Friends,

PERMIT PARKING

Due to continuing problems between residents and parents over parking, Southern Housing Group have arranged for UK Car Park Management Ltd to instigate and enforce permit-only parking in the residents' parking bays outside houses 46-56 in Oaklyn Gardens.

Signage will be going up shortly and patrols will then commence.

Much of the evidence will be photographic.
Fines will be from £60, rising to £100 and then
enforceable through the courts.
The school has no involvement in dealing with the
scheme once it has commenced.

<u>Dropping Off</u>

A polite reminder that we encourage parking away from the school - at Winchester House or the Football Club - and walking the last part. Parents continually come to see me worried about the quality of driving and parking in Oaklyn Gardens. There is no legal parking near the school entrance because it is an unsafe place to park - there is a bend and the gate area has to be kept clear.

I am fearful that a child will be hurt, so please think not only about your own needs and safety but those of others, thank you.
