We have high expectations that support the development of our pupils as effective, responsible citizens.

Behaviour in all contexts will be managed using a positive approach in order to maintain personal dignity and promote integrity, honesty and trust.

The Governors wish to emphasise that violence, threatening behaviour or abuse by parents towards the school staff will not be tolerated. In these cases parents may be banned from the school premises. If the parent continues to cause a disturbance they may be liable to prosecution.
