Well, it's been another busy week for everyone. There has been a real buzz of learning going on, both in school and at home... a few pictures to share with you...





### **Just a few reminders:**

- The only exceptions to this is if there is more than one child attending from one family and children are expected to arrive at the later arrival time and leave at the earliest departure time, for the Bubbles they are in.

The last day of this term is Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2020. Our development days are due to be spent reflecting on, reviewing and rewriting aspects of the school curriculum, in order to allow for at least a term of blended learning. We will open again in September for children in Y1 to Y6 on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020.
