2. Ensuring and encouraging positive relationships with pupils, parents, staff and visitors alike, leads to kind-hearted friendships and develops a good attitude for learning and laughter in learning.

5. It is the responsibility of staff to ensure that positive behaviour is consistently acknowledged, praised and encouraged.

Aims of our statement on behaviour

- a) To encourage all members of the school to be polite and respectful to one another and to visitors to the school and in our community.
- b) To develop a sense of self-control, self-regulation and self-respect to develop skills for now and in the future.
- c) To provide support and / or intervention for pupils who struggle to adhere to the five key rules or disrupt learning for themselves or others
- d) To provide access to support and advice for staff and parents when dealing with children's challenging behaviour to ensure their own wellbeing is considered equally important
- e) Provide a safe environment free from discrimination
- f) To ensure consistently effective management of teaching and learning with well-organised classes and lessons that are stimulating, appropriate and accessible for all.
- g) To clearly demonstrate the progression of rewards and sanctions within the schools behaviour policy.
